As a charitable organization we are unable to provide compensation for an intern's time. In some cases, students can receive school credits.

Specific duties include but are not limited to:

- Maintain open communications with Berks Nature staff regarding schedule, expectations, and areas of interest
- Assist in the monitoring and management of Berks Nature owned properties and easements
- Assist with outdoor conservation management work on farms, streams, planting trees etc.
- Assist with educational programs such as school field trips, Eco-Camp, community events/outreach, and nature pre-school to ensure positive visitor experience for all
- Assist with indoor duties such as scanning, filing, copying, data entry, cleaning, and organizing
- Assist with the preparation of baseline reporting and documents

- Assist with Social Media Marketing and other public communications
- Represent Berks Nature at events held at The Nature Place and other public areas
